

Suppliers Public AIC Plan

Note: Suppliers Public AIC Plans must be produced within 20 days of the AIC Plan being accepted by Naval Group, both initial and revised versions. The public AIC Plan is to be approved by Naval Group and the Commonwealth of Australia prior to being published on a Commonwealth internet website.

The public AIC Plan shall be written on a company letterhead, signed by a duly authorised officer of the supplier, and be presented in a format that can be published on a Commonwealth internet website. The public AIC Plan shall comply with the Commonwealth's adoption and implementation of Web Content Accessibility Guidelines.

The public AIC Plan shall include the following information, including using the same headings and structure:

Company Details:

Address / Location
Website Details

Executive Summary:

Provide a high-level overview of the contract, including details of the major work packages to be performed by Australian industry. In particular, the executive summary shall include:

- the scope of the contract with Naval Group;
- the scope of work to be performed by Australian Industry
- capabilities that will be sought from Australian Industry.

Scope of Future Work Opportunities:

Briefly describe the future opportunities for Australian industry including:

- the major equipment systems, services and related capabilities that will be sought;
- the location(s) where it is desirable for this work to be performed (where relevant);
- the timing for when the equipment, systems, services and related capabilities will be required; and
- any related research and development activities.

Future Opportunities Industry Engagement:

Briefly describe the process to be followed to engage Australian industry in the above opportunities, including:

- how these will be advertised (i.e. through the use of supplier advocates, Industry Capability Network, professional networks, business access arrangements or similar);
- how Australian Industry will be evaluated for supplier/subcontractor selection; and
- indicative timeframes for these engagement activities.

For future work opportunities, provide sufficient details that will enable Australian Industry to contact the appropriate representative from within the company in order to register their interest.
